- ✓ Check List: for baby's testing
 - Nursery noise less than 50dB
 - Baby asleep no more than 5 minutes
 - Screen started with Range Dial set to 60
 - Sound Level Microphone 2 inches away from Baby's ear
 - Mothers mouth arms length away from baby to avoid baby feeling mothers breath
 - Cover mouth when SS sounds are made
 - Each Ling Sound tested 3 times
 - If baby becomes fussy complete the screen a another time

Place an X in the box that corresponds to the sound and dB level that caused baby's arousal

When the screen is finished take the score sheet and screen kit to your doctor.

If your baby has aroused to the Ling Sounds at the 60 or 70 dB boxes your baby has normal hearing. However, hearing loss can develop during your child's first few years before your child will tell you about it. For this reason it is advisable to repeat the screen at 3 months, 6 months and one year.

If your baby is only aroused at 80 or 90 dB or not at all your child has a hearing loss. If the screen was done as part of a well baby clinic you will be referred to an otologist/audiologist team.
