BATTERY REPLACEMENT**

Eventually, all Envoy Esteem SP batteries reach their end of life (EOL), and the batteries become depleted. Two months prior to battery depletion, you will hear two tones when you turn on your Esteem. This is your signal to make arrangements to have your Esteem SP battery replaced.

Although most Esteem battery replacements are performed under local MAC anesthesia with sedation, some patients require a formal general anesthesia. It is important for us to know about your overall health and any medical issues prior to considering performing operations under general anesthesia.
